BACKGROUND

The Center for the Study of Local Issues (CSLI) was established in 1978 as a research agency operating within Anne Arundel Community College. Since 2006, CSLI has been part of the Sarbanes Center for Public and Community Service.

MISSION

CSLI's mission is to provide students and faculty with hands-on use of social science research methodologies as they apply to community concerns and to bring the college and the community together in an effort to better understand local issues.

This mission involves several goals:

- Providing students with engaged learning opportunities in applied settings
- Responding to community needs
- Promoting faculty professional development
- Assisting the college in monitoring the social, economic and political environment.

CSLI SURVEYS AND COMMUNITY OUTREACH

The center conducts a community survey each term. A variety of local and state topics are covered, such as growth, taxes, the economy, education, transportation, crime, the environment and more. Students participate in the design, data collection and analysis of the findings, thus gaining enhanced civic awareness as well as insight into social science methodologies.

Outreach activities include:

- Presenting survey findings at community meetings
- Distributing press releases
- Sponsoring candidate forums
